Action Taken Report on Students Feedback Analysis 2022-23

Feedback Summary:

- A significant portion of respondents were happy with the academic environment of the college.
- A lot of students voiced the demand for more field trips, industrial visits and excursions so that learning may move beyond the confines of the classroom.
- Majority of respondents agreed that the college provided ample co-curricular opportunities for holistic development of students.
- Students also wanted frequent career counselling sessions so that they have more knowledge about their post- collegiate professional options
- Some of the respondents from Psychology have suggested that Internships should make compulsory in the degree level.
- Respondents from CS department have suggested the inclusion of modern subjects such as artificial intelligence, machine learning and the incorporation of the latest programming languages.
- 91% of respondents stated that LISSAH's infrastructure is inclusive and responds to the needs of different stakeholders.
- Around 73% of respondents rated the hygiene and cleanliness of the classrooms and basic amenities in the college as Excellent' and 'Very good' while 25% of respondents expressed their satisfaction and a very minimal respondent marked dissatisfaction.

- Taking into account the feedback from students regarding their desire for frequent career counseling sessions, the department implemented a regular schedule of career counseling sessions, inviting professionals and alumni to provide insights, guidance, and information on various career paths.
- Based on the feedback received from respondents in the field of Psychology, who suggested making internships compulsory at the degree level, the institution araanges partnerships with relevant organizations to ensure a wide range of internship opportunities during summer vacation for students.
- The institution initiated the planning and organization of additional off-campus visits and educational excursions to enable learning experiences beyond the confines of the classroom.
- The Departments have been encouraged to include more field trips, industrial visits and excursions in their curriculum transaction so as to make teaching-learning an engaging process.
- Being an affiliated college of Calicut University, LISSAH College follows the designated syllabus of the University. During syllabus review and revision, few teachers from LISSAH participate in the process, so suggestions are conveyed to these teachers who are in positions of authority to forward them.
- As response to last year's feedback on canteen, the canteen facility has been relocated to a newly constructed area with ample space.
- The entire college's campus WiFi facility was upgraded, enhancing both bandwidth and speed.
- To address the limited availability of free time for extracurricular activities, the institution reassess the current schedule and prioritize high value activities while streamlining and optimizing existing programs to maximize time efficiency.

Action Taken Report on Students Feedback Analysis 2021-22

Feedback Summary:

- The feedback suggests that the majority of respondents had a positive experience with the syllabus, with a combined percentage of 51.77% rating it as excellent or very good. However, there is room for improvement, as 17.10% rated it as satisfactory.
- According to the feedback provided, the sequence of courses (subjects) in the curriculum received mixed reviews. Approximately 23.32% of respondents found the sequence to be excellent, while 28.50% considered it very good. Additionally, 36.27% rated the sequence as good. However, 8.81% found it satisfactory, and 3.11% deemed it unsatisfactory.
- According to the feedback regarding the availability and relevance of recommended textbooks in relation to the syllabus is mixed.
- The classroom and campus ambience received overwhelmingly positive feedback, with 65.16% rating it as excellent.
- The feedback suggests that there is room for improvement in the canteen facilities.
- The students univocally requested to upgrade the campus WiFi and internet facility.
